The Saint John Regional Hospital is a 529 bed teaching hospital affiliated with Dalhousie University with resident trainees in many disciplines. In the Fall of 2010, the Dalhousie New Brunswick Medical Education Program will be based on the adjacent property to the Saint John Regional Hospital at

the University of New Brunswick, Saint John campus.



Situated on the picturesque Bay of Fundy, Saint John offers numerous social and cultural facilities as well as numerous recreational opportunities. Being the only official bilingual province, there is access to both English and French school systems. The Saint John campus of the University of New Brunswick is adjacent to the Saint John Regional Hospital and offers a wide variety of undergraduate and postgraduate programs.

Applicants must be eligible for licensure in New Brunswick and hold specialty certification in Urology from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada or American Board certification. The successful candidate will be required to participate in the

teaching program of medical students and urology residents and the urology call schedule. The candidate may be eligible for an academic appointment with Dalhousie University.
