Martin Barkin Chair Of Division Of Urology, Department Of Surgery University Of Toronto

The Martin Barkin Chair of the Division of Urology is responsible for the academic activities and residency training in the Division and plays a coordinating role for activities that traverse our fully and partially affiliated teaching sites. The Division of Urology Surgery has 23 full time faculty members, 17 part time/adjunct faculty members, 22 residents training in fully accredited resident programs in Urology and 24 fellows.

The successful candidate must have an established record of scholarly achievement and be eligible for appointment at the rank of Associate or Full Professor. This five-year term is renewable for a second term after review. The preferred hospital site for the Chair's clinical activities is to be negotiated with the successful candidate should they be an external candidate. Candidates must be eligible for certification with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, and licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario.
